### **Hudson wins at New Forest Golf Club**

Southwood's Chris Hudson won the New Forest Golf Club Pro-Am with a five-under-par round of 64.

Swanmore's Mark Desmond and Roger Tuddenham (Hedge End Golf Centre) finished in joint second place on 68.

Hudson, the Hampshire PGA Captain, was playing the New Forest course for the very first time. His winning round had not got off to the best of starts when he dropped three shots at the second and third holes but he fought back with a barrage of birdies to set-up his winning score.

Hudson also won the Pro-Am with his InStock Windows team of Tom Grimes, Graham Squires and Andrew Squires. Their seventeen-under-par score of 121 was three shots better than Roger Tuddenham and his team of David Lawrence, Geoff Onoufriou and Craig Petrie (124).

One handicapper Petrie made five birdies and an eagle on the back nine to haul his team into second place. Third place went to Steve Richardson with his team of Peter Price, Martin Rudderham and Paul Baxter (125).
