## Hampshire PGA Report - David Wheeler, Secretary, Hampshire PGA

**Mackie wins at New Forest Golf Club** - Lee Mackie shot a four-under-par round of 65 to win last Friday's Pro-Am Tournament at a wet and windy New Forest Golf Club at Lyndurst. In testing conditions Mackie finished two shots ahead of Mark Dowdell (Blacknest) with Kevin Saunders (Walhampton), David Egan (Portsmouth Golf Centre) and Ben Johnson (Stoneham) sharing third place on 68. Victory earned Mackie a handsome cheque for £1,000.

The thirty-six teams that competed in the Tournament had to battle against frequent showers of driving rain. Late starters also had to contend with a thirty minute suspension of play when a heavy shower rendered the course unplayable. For much of the day volunteers had been queegying greens and as darkness threatened they came to the rescue once again to ensure that the day's play could be completed.

Eddy Rawlings (Southwick Park) and his team of Rob Ryan, Neil Taylor and Mark Cording won the pro-am with an eighteen-under-par score of 120. They finished an incredible seven shots clear of their nearest rivals. Second place went to Blackmoor's Steve Mitchell and his team of Les Barton, Gary White and Keith Barrow after a countback. Mark Dowdell, Bill Begg, Mike Malone and Graham Lewis were third.

'Nearest the Pin' prizes were won by Andy Hall, Neil Cannard, Stephen Snow, Shona Mountford, Doug Moore, Pete Christie and Rob Ryan. 'Longest Drive' prizes went to Peter Williams, Craig Mansbridge & Brenda Amos while the Kings Volvo 'What's the Score' competition was won by Paul Hanvey and Steve Patrick.
